

Robot-assisted Surgery

In Western Australia, robot-assisted surgery for gynaecology and gynaecological oncology was pioneered by Dr Jason Tan using the da Vinci® Surgical System.

The da Vinci[®] Surgical System is powered by state-of-the-art robotic technology. It allows the surgeon's hand movements to be scaled, filtered and translated into precise movements of microinstruments within the operative site.

The da Vinci[®] Surgical System enhances surgical capabilities by enabling the performance of complex operations through tiny surgical openings.

The single-site robot-assisted surgery is first made available in Western Australia through collaboration between the WOMEN Centre and the St John of God Subiaco Hospital.

The single-site robot-assisted surgery is an almost scar-less procedure where the surgery is performed through a small cut in the patient's belly button.

This results in an almost scar-less surgical site similar to the minimally invasive, single incision laparoscopic surgery.

Robot-assisted Singlesite and Single-incision Laparoscopic Surgery

The single-site robot-assisted surgery is available for gallbladder removal, and benign (non cancer) hysterectomy and ovary removal. Early clinical data shows that a single-site robot-assisted hysterectomy performed with the da Vinci [®] Surgical System has these potential benefits:

- Low blood loss^{1,2,3,4}
- Low rate of complications^{1,2}
- Low chance of a blood transfusion²
